#### **Event Overview:**

A celebration of Puerto Rican-American arts and culture has been observed by the Greater Cleveland community each summer since 1969. Its purpose has been to bring the city's residents together, highlighting its rich diversity, and educate the community about the many contributions to the city's history and beyond.

The EXPO includes ongoing programming and workshops which span over 7 months. The highlight of which is a two day event starting on August 5, 2023 with exhibits, local artisans, and cultural presentations. The second day kicks off with a one-mile community building caravan of visual arts and creative floats led by the city's Mayor and other civic leaders. The caravan proudly showcases the diversity among Hispanic organizations, businesses, and civic groups that contribute to the development of Northeast Ohio.

The EXPO aims to educate and empower the Cleveland community by presenting workshops (in partnership with the Cleveland Museum of Art and the Cleveland Public Library), educational presentations, and displays of the story of Puerto Rican-Americans and their traditions. Some of these include teaching the significance and meaning of many Taíno hieroglyphics; carvings that have a special significance and insight into the story of the indigenous people of Puerto Rico.

Community health partners provide screenings and services, free of charge, to collectively address social determinants of health. The EXPO's impact helps reduce health disparities and brings us closer to reaching health equity in the heart of the Clark-Fulton neighborhood, the most densely Hispanic populated enclave in the State of Ohio.

Regional and internationally known artists are presented during our highlight event, attracting many attendees. Through our vendor opportunities, local residents are inspired into entrepreneurship, fostering new economic development in the neighborhood and eliminating economic barriers.

The EXPO culminates during Hispanic Heritage Month in a celebratory event that recognizes countless volunteer hours, partnerships, and professional development.
